KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA IN BARMER AND JAISALMER

†3467. COL. SONARAM CHOUDHARY:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up new Kendriya Vidyalaya or Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya in Barmer and Jaisalmer districts by relaxing the norms for remote and desert areas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) No such proposal is under consideration of the Government at present.
- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) Proposals for opening of new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are considered only if sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India, State Governments / Union Territories Administrations or Organization of employees belonging to the eligible categories thereby committing resources for setting up a new KV as well as on the availability of necessary sanction of the Government. At present 4 KVs are functioning at Ramgarh, Dabla, Jaisalmer and Pokhran in District Jaisalmer and 3 KVs are functioning at Jalipa, Uttarlai and Jaisindhar in District Barmer.

Navodaya Vidyalaya Scheme provides for opening of one Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV) in each district of the country. One JNV in Barmer and another in Jaisalmer District are already functioning smoothly from their permanent buildings.
