(a) to (d): The Ministry has launched IMPacting Research Innovation and Technology (IMPRINT) on 5th November, 2015 as a pan- Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) and Indian Institute of Science (IISc) initiative to develop a roadmap for research to solve major engineering and technology challenges in ten technology domains relevant to India. The Indian Institute of Sciences, Bangalore and the Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay are coordinating the initiative on environmental science & climate change and energy security, respectively, under IMPRINT.
