GIs for Teacher Educational Colleges

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) has come across cases where many colleges that had obtained recognition on one address have been running from some other campuses;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the NCTE has asked all teacher education colleges to submit Geographic Information System (GIS) to identify such colleges which had obtained recognition on one address and have been running from some other campuses;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the action taken by the Government against such colleges which have not submitted GIS?

(a) & (b) The National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) has informed that no such case has come to its notice.

(c) to (e) After notification of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, NCTE has developed a transparent database of Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs), and has launched its dynamic website on 28.05.2015. Further, NCTE Geographic Information System (GIS) Platform has been launched on 26.06.2015. Till date, 11,789 TEIs have filed their profile on the GIS platform and 1025 of those have been uploaded on the NCTE GIS website. The applications with inaccuracies have been returned to the respective TEIs for rectification.
