### Non-Teaching Staff

#### 3517. SHRI NABA KUMAR SARANIA:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has noticed that Non-Teaching staff working in institutions of Higher Education lack legal provision for a uniform staff pattern;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is aware that Non-Teaching Staff are not brought within the purview of the UGC and other regulatory bodies and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government for coverage of Non-Teaching staff in institutions of Higher Education for revision of pay scale to ensure parity with similar scientific institutions, Research Organisations in the country?

# ANSWER MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) to (c) On the advice of MHRD, University Grants Commission (UGC) Joint Cadre Review Committee (JCRC) has reviewed the pay scales and designations of the non-teaching staff of Central Universities, UGC maintained Deemed to be Universities and Delhi Colleges.
- (d) UGC extends the Central Pay Commission recommendations as approved by Government of India to the non-teaching staff of the Central Universities, UGC maintained deemed to be Universities and Colleges affiliated to University of Delhi. It is also applicable to other Quasi Govt. Organization / Statutory Bodies etc. set up by and funded / controlled by Central Government. The State government / Management of the Institutions concerned other than those mentioned above have to take a decision to adopt the pay scales as recommended by the Central Pay Commission(s) for which, no financial assistance can be expected from UGC / Central Government.
