**EMPLOYMENT IN STEEL SECTOR**

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has made assessment of the increasing opportunities of employment in the steel sector;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the employment generated through Steel Industry during each of the last three years and the current year; and
- (c) the details of the policy prepared by the Government for employment generation in Steel Sector in future along with the funds allocated for the purpose?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI VISHNU DEO SAI)

(a) Government engaged Indian Institute of Metal (IIM), Kolkata in March, 2007 for a comprehensive study on technical manpower requirement at different levels in the steel industry. The report has been submitted by IIM, Kolkata to Ministry of Steel in March, 2008 which inter-alia covers discipline-wise requirement of technical manpower needed by the iron and steel industry by the year 2020, including shortages thereof.

(b)&(c): Steel being a deregulated sector, the employment decisions are taken by the individual steel companies, hence, the details of year-wise employment generated through steel industry is not maintained in the Ministry of Steel.
