INTEGRATED DAIRY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

358. DR. BANSHILAL MAHATO:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has received proposals/requests from the State Government of Chhattisgarh to launch Integrated Dairy Development Projects under the National Dairy Development Scheme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the funds has not been released to Chhattisgarh State under the said National Dairy Development Project;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the time by which the funds are likely to be sanctioned and released?

ANSWER

- (a) &(b) The scheme “Integrated Dairy Development Programme”, renamed as “Intensive Dairy Development Programme (IDDP)” was implemented across the country from the year 1993-94 to 2013-14. IDDP scheme has been discontinued from 2014-15. Ongoing projects along with its objectives and targets have been subsumed under the new Scheme “National Programme for Bovine Breeding and Dairy Development (NPBBDD)” for implementation during the 12th Five Year Plan. This Department has approved a new project under dairy development component of NPBBDD in Chhattisgarh covering Balod, Bemetra, Kanker and Janjgir-Champa districts with project outlay of Rs1086.28 lakh (including Central share of Rs 915.40 lakh) for implementation during the period from 2014-15 to 2018-19.
- (c) &(d) An amount of Rs 223.20 lakh has been released for implementation of project till 31.10.2015.
