## INTEGRATED DAIRY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

358. DR. BANSHILAL MAHATO:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:
(a) whether the Union Government has received proposals/requests from the State Government of Chhattisgarh to launch Integrated Dairy Development Projects under the National Dairy Development Scheme;
(b) if so, the details thereof;
(c) whether the funds has not been released to Chhattisgarh State under the said National Dairy Development Project;
(d) if so, the reasons therefor; and
(e) the time by which the funds are likely to be sanctioned and released?

ANSWER

(a) \&(b) The scheme "Integrated Dairy Development Programme", renamed as "Intensive Dairy Development Programme (IDDP)" was implemented across the country from the year 1993-94 to 2013-14. IDDP scheme has been discontinued from 2014-15. Ongoing projects along with its objectives and targets have been subsumed under the new Scheme "National Programme for Bovine Breeding and Dairy Development (NPBBDD)" for implementation during the $12^{\text {th }}$ Five Year Plan. This Department has approved a new project under dairy development component of NPBBDD in Chhattisgarh covering Balod, Bemetra, Kanker and Janjgir-Champa districts with project outlay of Rs1086.28 lakh ( including Central share of Rs 915.40 lakh) for implementation during the period from 2014-15 to 2018-19.
(c) \&(d) An amount of Rs 223.20 lakh has been released for implementation of project till 31.10.2015.
(e) Does not arise in view of (c) above
