VACANT POSTS IN DGFASLI

3606. SHRI B. VINOD KUMAR:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Government proposes to increase the number of posts in Directorate General of Factory Advice Service and Labour Institutes (DGFASLI) in order to improve efficiency of the institute;
- (b)if so, the details thereof;
- (c)whether the Government is also considering for upgrading of the overall infrastructure of DGFASLI and if so, the details of action taken in this regard and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d)whether feedback is being taken from trainees who attend the training programs of DGFASLI so as to improve the program efficiency and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI BANDARU DATTATREYA)

(a) & (b): A study of manpower was conducted by Staff Inspection Unit of Department of Expenditure and had recommended re-sizing of manpower of DGFASLI. The recommendations of the SIU have been implemented in consultation with Department of Expenditure in 2009. The process has been initiated to assess the manpower requirements keeping in view the requirements of occupational safety, health and working conditions.

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(c): For the overall development and up-gradation of infrastructure of DGFASLI, following plan scheme are being implemented by DGFASLI:

- i) Strengthening of DGFASLI Organization & Occupational Safety and Health in Factories, Ports and Docks.
- ii) Establishment of Regional Labour Institute (RLI), Faridabad/Development of RLI Faridabad as National Centre of Excellence.
- iii) Establishment of Regional Labour Institute at Shillong for North East Region.

(d): The feedback system has been introduced in all the training programs organized and conducted by DGFASLI and based on the feedback received improvements are made.

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
