- (a) Yes, Madam. All the Central Universities are implementing Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in all Postgraduate Programmes from the academic session 2015-2016.
- (b) University Grants Commission (UGC) has brought out the Guidelines on adoption of Choice Based Credit System with a view to bringing in the desired uniformity in grading system and method for computing the cumulative grade point average (CGPA) based on the performance of students in the examinations and to ensure seamless mobility of students across the higher education institutions across the country as well as abroad.
