ENCROACHMENT OF INDUS VALLEY SITES

- (a) whether the Government has taken steps to prevent encroachment on 5000 year old Indus Valley civilization site in Alamgirpur, Baghpat district, Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the action taken by the Government against the persons responsible for encroachment?
