SECURITY OF DELHI METRO

†3691. SHRI DEVJI M. PATEL:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the existing strength and requirement of security personnel in Delhi Metro;
- (b) whether security rules have been violated for more than 60 times this year due to the lack of security personnel in the Delhi Metro;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the total number of such cases reported and the action taken against the guilty personnel during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (d) whether the Government has also received complaints that people are entering metro stations without getting their bags checked;
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the action taken in this regard; and
- (f) the corrective steps taken by the Government to improve security in Delhi Metro and the other measures taken to check such cases in future?

ANSWER

- (a): The existing strength of CISF in Delhi Metro is 4869. The strength augmentation proposal of CISF in DMRC is 2120 for Phase I&II.

(f): Corrective steps are taken as and when required. Some steps taken recently are given below:-

- i) The height of side gates separating unpaid and paid area have been increased significantly so that no passenger can pass any unchecked material from the side gate.
- ii) CISF Unit at DMRC Delhi has detailed spotters in plain clothes in vulnerable places, where there are chances of unchecked bags being passed.
- iii) Comprehensive report on structural/security loopholes has been prepared and sent to DMRC management.
- iv) Group patrolling of Metro Stations is done by SHO and staff from Metro Police Stations. Police Assistance Booths are also functioning at major Metro Stations.
