SPY PIGEON

3861. PROF. K.V. THOMAS:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a spy pigeon from Pakistan has been caught in India in the month of May, 2015;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the spy work of Pakistan against India is increasing; and
- (d) if so, the action taken in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): No such incident has come to the notice of the Government of India.

(c) & (d): The Government has been pursuing a well coordinated and multi pronged approach to tackle espionage activities which include strengthening vigilance on the borders to check infiltration/illegal cross border activities and close interaction and coordination between intelligence Agencies of the Centre and the State Governments. This has resulted in neutralization of a large number of espionage networks.
