SHRI DUSHYANT SINGH:

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the total number of hostels constructed for the SC and OBC students across the country during the year 2014-15, State-wise;

(b) whether the Government has received a proposal from the Rajasthan Government for the construction of 17 hostel buildings for SC and OBC students;

(c) if so, the details thereof and the total funds required for the implementation of said proposal; and

(d) the time by which the proposal is likely to be approved/implemented?

(a): The State-wise details of the number of hostels sanctioned for construction/expansion under the Scheme (i) 'Babu Jagjivan Ram Chhartrawas Yojna (BJRCY)' for SC students; and (ii) Construction of hostels for OBC Boys and Girls during the year 2014-15 is annexed.

(b) & (c): During the year 2014-15, 03 complete proposals for construction/expansion of 11 hostels were received from the Government of Rajasthan under BJRCY. These proposals were approved and eligible central assistance of Rs. 1.26 crore and Rs. 13.50 crore have been released during 2014-15 and 2015-16 respectively.

No complete proposal was received from the Government of Rajasthan during 2014-15 under the Scheme 'Construction of hostels for OBC Boys and Girls'. (d): Question does not arise.
