Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has made any progress with regard to the implementation of the pilot project under Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Satellite Towns around seven mega cities and if so the town-wise details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has proposes any clean / green alternative for managing underground sewerage, solid waste management and water supply under the scheme and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the time-line for extending the pilot projects to other towns in various other States, including in Karnataka?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT

(SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

(a): Yes, Madam. Under the Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Satellite Towns around Seven Mega Cities (UIDSST), 7 towns namely, Pilkhuwa (U.P.), Vikarabad (Telangana), Sriperumbudur (Tamil Nadu), Sonapat (Haryana), Vasai-Virar (Maharashtra), Hoskote (Karnataka) including Sanand (Gujarat), have been covered. A total number of 17 projects are being implemented under the scheme with an approved cost of Rs.631.07 crore, of which Central share is Rs.500 crore. The total

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central assistance of Rs.348.61 crore has been released till 16.12.2015. Details of fund released, State-wise / town-wise under the UIDSST scheme is at Annexure-I.

(b): The Urban Local Bodies of Satellite towns have been advised not only to recycle and reuse the waste generated but also to minimize the waste generation.

(c): It has been decided that no new town / project will be taken up under the scheme. Only committed liability is to be fulfilled.
