CONSTRUCTION OF SULABH TOILETS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the names of the railway stations where construction of sulabh toilet complex is desired in various States and Union Territories of the country;**
- (b) the allocation of funds made for construction of sulabh toilet complex at railway stations during the last three years, Zone/State-wise;**
- (c) the progress made in this regard;**
- (d) whether there is a dire need of construction of sulabh toilet complex and small urinals at Degana Railway Station of Nagaur district; and**
- (e) if so, the details of the plan for its construction?**

ANSWER

(SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a): Construction of any amenities including toilets (Pay & Use/non Pay & Use) at stations is a continuous process & is**

undertaken depending upon category of stations subject to inter-se priority and availability of funds.

(b) & (c): Toilets are constructed as a part of passenger amenity and is chargeable under the Plan Head- 'Passenger Amenities'. No specific allocation is made for construction of sulabh toilet complex.

(d) & (e): Degana is a 'D' category station. 5 toilets & 5 urinals are already available which is considered to be adequate.
