Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has received any proposal in regard to providing rail inter-connectivity between Central Western Railway and sub-urban service of harbor line to link Navi Mumbai and extend it upto Konkan railway;

(a) if so, the details thereof; and

(b) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

(SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

(a) to (c) : Central and Western Railway routes are already connected to Harbor line and suburban services of Harbor line extends from Chatrapati Shivaji Terminus to Panvel in Navi Mumbai area. Roha in Konkan Railway is connected to Harbor line at Panvel.

A proposal has been received for Virar-Vasai-Panvel suburban corridor to further connect Western Railways and Harbor line of Central Railway. Central Railway has been advised to examine the techno-economic feasibility of the proposal.

There is no proposal for extending suburban services from Harbor line to Konkan Railway.
