- (a) whether the Government has any plan to set up a robust broad gauge railway network in North Eastern States and connect it to the Trans-Asia Railway Network within a fixed time frame; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) & (b) : Master plan has been made for a broad gauge network in North Eastern States. Broad features of this plan are:
- (1) Connectivity to all State capitals.
- (2) Unigauge Broadgauge network.
- (3) Strengthening international borders.
- (4) Augmentation of network capacity for handling growth of traffic in future.
- (5) Expansion of network to unconnected areas of the region.
- (6) Improving trade and connectivity with neighbouring countries.

Time frame to connect with Trans-Asia Railway Network has not been fixed due to a number of missing links in and outside India.
