- (a) In conformity with the "Skill India Mission" of the Government, Maulana Azad National Academy for Skills (MANAS) has been established on 11/11/2014 as a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) for providing an integrated institutional arrangement, to meet all skill development/skill upgradation needs of the minority communities and provide sustainable livelihood options in terms of self-employment/wage-employment opportunities with primary focus on self- employment with credit linkages.
- (b) The State-wise and skill-wise number of minority youth trainedby MANAS as on date are at **Annexure-I**.
- (c) The State-wise number of Madarsas currently involved by MANAS are as follows:
 - 1) Bihar 3 (three) Madarsas
 - 2) Maharashtra 1 (one) Madarsa
- (d) No such projects have been taken up by MANAS.
