- (a) the details of the revenue generated from telecom sector during the last three years and the current year, year-wise and its percentage share in the GDP;
- (b) whether the telecom sector is becoming the second largest revenue earner in India's economy; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government for its growth?

(a) to (c) The revenue generated in telecom sector during the last three years and current year and its percentage share in Gross Domestic Product(GDP) is given as under:-

2011-12	185930	2.10
2012-13	207498	2.07
2013-14	219553	1.93
2014-15	242900	1.94
