(a) and (b): The Government of India is implementing the 'Digital India' programme with the vision to transform India into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy.

Under the National e-Governance Action Plan which is now subsumed under Digital India, core infrastructure components (Electronic delivery of services, the Government is implementing 44 Mission Mode Projects and core infrastructure components (State Data Centres (SDCs), State Wide Area Networks (SWANs), Common Services Centres (CSCs), State e-Governance Service Delivery Gateway (SSDGs), e-District and Capacity Building) have been allocated sufficient resources for the state of Andhra Pradesh.
