INSURANCE OF LUGGAGE OF PASSENGERS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :

- (a) whether the Government proposes to compensate for passengers baggage lost during travel undertaken by them on reserved ticket and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) whether the Government also proposes to compensate the losses out of the insurance cover bought along with the reserved ticket;**
- (c) if so, the details thereof;**
- (d) whether the passengers have to pay premium for insurance of said baggage; and**
- (e) if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS
(SHRI MANOJ SINHA)**

- (a) : No, Madam. There is no such proposal because the responsibility of taking care of baggage during journey by train is that of passenger only.**
- (b) : There is no insurance cover as of now on the reserved tickets.**
