Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has direct access to data of the operations of Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether information of such data is inadequate to assess the actual training capacity in the country;
- (d) if so, the reaction of the Government thereon; and the total number of Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in the country with the details of these Institutes run by the Government and private sectors respectively, State-wise;
- (e) whether the National Skill Development Association (NSDA) had requested the National Sample Survey Organisation (NSSO) to incorporate new questions to capture details into their household and enterprise surveys and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d) Vocational Training is a concurrent subject under the Constitution. The Central Government is entrusted with responsibility of formulation of policy, laying down training standards, norms, conduct of examinations & certification etc. whereas day to day administration is under the domain of respective State/UTs. Government of India has started portal (<https://ncvtmis.gov.in/Pages/Home.aspx>) to capture data of Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), admission of trainees & examinations including issue of Hall tickets & certificates to successful trainees etc. There are 13105 number of ITIs in the country including 10812 number in private sector.

(e) In order to assess existing training capacity and requirement, sector-wise in the country, NSDA has requested NSSO to incorporate questions relating to "skilling" aspect in their regular surveys such as Household Survey and Enterprise Survey. The NSSO has considered the request and has incorporated some questions on skilling in their Enterprise Survey that started in July, 2015 and is in process of suitably incorporating the questions in upcoming rounds of other surveys as well.
