- (a) the names of the social organisations or public sector undertakings which have undertaken implementation of the sanitation programme in urban areas of Rajasthan;
- (b) the city-wise and organisation/undertaking-wise details thereof;
- (c) the number of public sector undertakings which come under the ambit of the Corporate Social Responsibilities (CSRs) rules along with the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government has taken cognizance of cases of violation of provisions of the said rules and if so, the number of such undertakings along with the nature of action taken/being taken against such undertakings by the Government; and
- (e) whether the Government proposes to close down such undertakings, if so, the details thereof?
