- (v) 12621/12622 Chennai Central -New Delhi Tamil Nadu Express (daily)
- (vi) 16031/16032 Chennai Central -Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Katra Andaman Express (tri-weekly)
- (vii) 12641/12642 Kanniyakumari-Hazrat Nizamuddin Thirukkural Express (bi-weekly)
- (viii) 12651/12652 Madurai-Hazrat Nizamuddin Tamil Nadu Sampark Kranti Express (bi-weekly)
- (ix) 12687/12688 Madurai-Dehradun/Chandigarh Express (bi-weekly)
