489. SHRI VINOD LAKHAMASHI CHAVDA:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Railway Schools in the country at present;
- (b) whether it is a fact that there is acute shortage of teachers in Railway Schools in the country including Gujarat;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the action being taken by the Government to fill up the vacant posts at the earliest?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

(a): Indian Railways is running 150 Railway schools in the country.

(b) to (d): Certain vacancies of teachers do exist in Railway schools. However, occurrence of vacancies is a natural and continuous process for which indents are placed on the Railway Recruitment Boards by the concerned Zonal Railways and recruitments also take place.
