Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of proposals sent by the State Government of Bihar regarding development of college education and amount of funds demanded during the last three years;
- (b) the number of proposals sanctioned and the funds released for said purpose during the last three years; and
- (c) the number of proposals lying pending with the Government along with the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b) : Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Rashtriya Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), the State of Bihar submitted its State Higher Education Plan (SHEP) in 2014 with a proposed total requirement of Rs 562.90 crore for 2014-17. The number of proposals submitted by the State for each component and approved by the Project Approval Board (PAB) of RUSA is at **Annexure**.

An amount of Rs 2.626 crore has been released as Preparatory Grants and Grants for Monitoring Management Evaluation and Research (MMER) till date.

(c) No proposal is pending for appraisal by the PAB. Release of further funding to the State is contingent upon furnishing of utilisation details, in conformity with the scheme norms by the State Government.
