IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW RAILWAY LINE

501. SHRI ANTO ANTONY:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of implementation of Angamaly-Sabarimala Railway line in Kerala;
- (b) the details of major reasons for inordinate delay in implementing the above line;
- (c) whether a field office is functioning for implementation of this project and if so, the details thereof including expenses incurred by the Government in this regard so far;
- (d) whether the Government has any plan to abandon this project; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof including reasons for such decision?

ANSWER

- (a) Track linking on Angamali-Kaladi section (7 Km) of the project has been completed. Earthwork and bridge works have been taken up in Kaladi-Perumbavoor (11 Km) section.
- (b) This project has suffered delay due to late finalization of alignment by State Government, local resistance against land acquisition, court cases, abnormal increase in land cost, etc.

- (c) Construction Office at Ernakulam is implementing Angamali-Sabarimala new line project. An expenditure of ₹163 crore has been incurred on this project upto March, 2015.
