Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that electrification work on Bangalore-Mysore segment is not progressing at the desired level;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether the paucity of funds is one of the main reasons for slow pace of work;**
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and**
- (e) the steps taken to allocate sufficient funds so that the work could be completed in a time bound manner?**

(a) & (b): Bangalore-Kengeri rail line is already electrified. Electrification work of Kengeri- Mysore of South Western Railway is a part of sanctioned Ramanagaram-Mysore doubling with electrification work, and the work is progressing as per schedule commensurate with the progress of doubling work in the section.

(c) to (e): There is no paucity of funds for the project. Sufficient funds have been provided for this project.
