515. SHRI SIRAJUDDIN AJMAL:

Will the Minister of DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION be pleased to state:

- (a) The details of various developmental schemes/projects under various heads for the North-Eastern States sanctioned, implemented and under implementation during each of the last three years and the current year, schemes and State-wise;
- (b) The details of ongoing projects incurring time and cost overruns in these States, State-wise;
- (c) The mechanism put in place to monitor and evaluate the progress of these schemes; and
- (d) Details about new proposals of schemes/projects under processing, State/UT-wise?

(a) & (b) The number of development schemes/ projects for the North-Eastern States during last three years under various heads are given at Annexure. Data regarding time overrun is given at column 4 of the Annexure. However, data regarding cost overrun is not centrally maintained, as the release by this Ministry is limited to the cost reflected in the initial concept/proposal.

(c) The projects are monitored through Quarterly Project Reports(QPR), field visits by Area Officials/Nodal Officials from DoNER, State Govt. officials and inspections made by the Independent Quality Monitors (IQMs). Project Portal (nlcpr.mdoner.gov.in) has recently being launched for monitoring of projects under NLCPR.

(d) Under the "Capacity Building and Technical Assistance" programme, 14 institutions have been finalised for training of 2715 persons in the current year.

(II) Non Lapsable Central Pool of Resources (NLCPR - CENTRAL)

There is one ongoing project in the NLCPR (Central) namely Tuirial Hydro Electric Power (60MW) implemented by North Eastern Electricity Power Corporation Ltd. (NEEPCO).

(III) North East Rural Livelihood Project (NERLP)

This is a World Bank funded project covering four States.

(IV) North East State Road Investment Project (NESRIP)

NESRIP is an Asian Development Bank (ADB) funded project being implemented in six states.
