- (a) the details of major and minor train accidents and derailment including goods trains during the last three years, year-wise and zone-wise along with the reasons therefor;
- (b) the details of casualties and losses suffered by the Railways in terms of revenue and property along with the compensation paid to the victims;
- (c) whether the Railways has conducted any inquiry into these train accidents and if so, the outcome thereof and the action taken on these reports/recommendations;
- (d) whether the Railways Kaya Kalp Committee headed by Shri Tata has made any suggestions to bring down train accidents; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Railways to avoid occurrence of accidents?

(b): Details of number of casualties, loss of railway property and revenue, including payments in respect of passengers who suffered loss of life or injury in train accidents during the last three years, i.e. 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15 are provided as under:

Note: Compensation paid in a year does not necessarily relate to the accidents in that year. The amount of compensation depends upon the number of cases finalized by Railway Claims Tribunal in a particular year irrespective of the year(s) in which the accidents have occurred.

(c): Consequential train accidents on Indian Railways are inquired into

either by Commissioner of Railway Safety (CRS) under the Ministry of Civil Aviation or Departmental Inquiry Committee of the Railway. During the last three years, i.e. 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15 and in the current year upto 15th November, 2015, a total of 271 consequential train accidents (excluding incidents at unmanned level crossings caused due to negligence of road vehicle users) occurred on Indian Railways. Based on the findings as contained in accident inquiry reports and/or is currently available as prima-facie cause, 190 accidents were caused due to failure of Railway Staff, 29 due to failure on the part of other than Railway staff, 13 due to failure of equipments, 11 due to Sabotage, 24 due to Incidental factors, cause in respect of 2 train accidents could not be established and CRS's (Commissioner of Railway Safety) findings in respect of 2 train accidents are presently awaited. In respect of 190 accidents attributable to failure of Railway Staff, disciplinary action has been initiated against 505 railway employees, disciplinary proceedings have been finalised in 479 cases and while major penalties have been imposed in 283 cases, minor penalties have been imposed on 196 number of railway staff.
