(SUTP) is to strengthen capacity of Government of India, participating States and cities in planning, financing, implementing, operating and managing sustainable urban transport systems and also to assist States and cities in preparing and implementing certain demonstration "Green Transport" projects towards reduction of Green House Gases (GHG) in the urban environment. It has following 03 components:

- i) National Capacity Development initiatives
- ii) Implementation of Demonstration Projects in select cities.
- iii) Project Management.

Total cost of the SUTP is Rs. 1,898.13 Crore (approx.).
