585. SHRI JOSE K. MANI:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a high level delegation visited China's famous railway universities earlier this year;
- (b) if so, the recommendations of the delegation;
- (c) whether the Railways has shelved the plan to open railway universities in the country as propagated by the Prime Minister last year;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) if not, the progress made in the direction of setting up these universities?

ANSWER

The delegation has recommended tie ups with Chinese Universities and Training Institutes to the extent of designing multi-disciplinary and multi-speciality course content and detailed course-curriculum, design and development of research centres and joint research programmes.
