#### **INCOME FROM FREIGHT CHARGES**

## †597. SHRI RAM CHARAN BOHRA:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of divisions/zones in the Railways and the division/zone which has received maximum income from freight charges;
- (b) the profit/loss earned by various divisions during the last three years, along with the division-wise details thereof;
- (c) whether any proposal is under consideration of the Government to frame any scheme to maximise the profit of those zones/divisions which have earned less profit; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

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STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 597 BY SHRI RAM CHARAN BOHRA TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 02.12.2015 REGARDING INCOME FROM FREIGHT CHARGES.

- (a): There are 17 zones and 68 divisions in the Indian Railways. The earnings of Railways is compiled Zonal railway-wise. East Coast Railway has earned ₹ 11379.40 crore towards freight earnings during 2014-15 which is the maximum among the 17 Zonal Railways. Zone-wise freight earnings for the year 2014-15 and 2015-16(upto Oct.-15) are appended as Appendix-I.
- (b): On the Indian Railways, Profit (Surplus)/Loss (Shortfall) are calculated only on Zonal Railway basis and not division-wise. Zonewise Surplus/ Shortfall generated during last three years i.e. 2012-13, 2013-14 & 2014-15 is appended as Appendix-II.
- (c) & (d): There is no division/zone specific scheme introduced as such to maximize profit. However, maximization of revenue generation across all zonal railways and improvement of their Operating Ratio is a thrust area. It is a continuous endeavour of the Railways to increase revenues. Steps taken for maximizing the freight earnings, inter-alia, include rationalization of freight tariff, effective marketing strategies to capture more traffic, creation of additional capacity and optimum utilization of the existing rail infrastructure, improved throughput through increased productivity and efficiency, reduction in wagon turnaround time, etc.
