- (a) whether the Government has conducted the Survey of new railway line between Kaniyur (Karnataka)-Kanhangad (Kerala) announced in the Railway budget;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the time by which the survey of above line would be conducted?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Survey for this new line has already been taken up. The survey requires investigation of one or more routes, in consultation with State Government & forest department, trade and industries, etc. for deciding the most technically feasible alignment. Since this is an extensive exercise, no time frame has been fixed for completion of this survey.
