- (e) : Merit-cum Means based Scholarship Scheme is on National Scholarship Portal (NSP) which was launched by the Government in July, 2015. Now the process of submission of applications, screening of applications, release of scholarship in the bank accounts through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode is completely online. National Scholarship Portal on one hand ensures speedy implementation and on the other transparency and accountability.
