(c) whether at present the occupancy in business class is about 40 per cent while in first class it is just about 20 per cent, if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether AI is aiming for 80 per cent occupancy in both the segments; and

(c) if so, the details thereof along with the steps taken/proposed to be taken in this regard?

(b): Yes, Madam. Air India is targeting Passenger Revenue of Rs.17017 crores in the Budget Estimates for Financial Year 2015-16 as compared to the Passenger Revenue of Rs.15793.36 crores achieved in Financial Year 2014-15 i.e. an increase of Rs.1223.64 crores i.e. 7.75%.

(c): Yes, Madam.

(d) & (e): Air India has taken the following steps to improve the current seat occupancy in the First Class and Business Class:

i) Offering attractive fares in the First Class and Business Class.

ii) e Super Saver Scheme for Business Class on www.airindia.in.

iii) Upgrade from a) Economy to Executive Class b) Executive to First Class with the 'Get Upfront Offer' at the airport a nominal charge, to prevent last minute seat spoilage.

iv) Short term cut and pay incentive scheme for travel agents in India for First and Business Class.
