SETTING UP OF NEW TERMINAL AT IGIA

- (a) whether there is any proposal to set up a new terminal at Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA), New Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the total number of passengers using various domestic/International airports in the country on daily basis, Airport-wise; and
- (d) the details of the criteria followed to set up new aviation hubs in the country?

(a) & (b): All the developments at Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA), New Delhi is undertaken in accordance with the Master Plan prepared by Delhi International Airport Limited (DIAL) and is linked to traffic growth at the IGI Airport, New Delhi. DIAL is in the process of updating the Master Plan, which contemplates setting up of a new terminal once DIAL achieves certain traffic triggers.

(c): The total number of passengers using various airports in the country on daily basis Airport-wise domestic/International, is at Annexure-I

(d): The primary criteria to set up a new aviation hub is: an international airport, located in metro cities, being geographically and demographically disperse, have high traffic potentials and large catchment areas.
