BHEL SOLAR POWER PROJECT AT FULERA

+785. SHRI RAHUL KASWAN:

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited proposes to set up a 4000 MW solar power project in Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the details and the locations thereof; and
- (c) the progress made so far in this regard?

ANSWER

(a),(b)&(c): There was a proposal to set up Ultra Mega Solar Power Project of capacity 4000 MW in Phases, at surplus salt pan land at Sambhar (Rajasthan), by a Joint Venture Company (JVC), the partners of which are M/s Bharat Heavy Electrical Limited (BHEL), M/s Sambhar Salt Limited (SSL), M/s Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI), M/s Power Grid Corporation of India Limited (POWERGRID), M/s Satluj Jal Vidyut Nigam Limited (SJVN) and M/s Rajasthan Electricals and Instruments Limited (REIL). An MOU for creation of a Joint Venture Company consisting of above six CPSEs was signed on 29-01-2014. The proposal was deferred due to objections raised by Rajasthan Government saying that the proposal would have an adverse environmental impact productivity of aquatic flora and fauna of the region.
