Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is considering to open a school of Indian languages in Jawaharlal Nehru University with a view to promote Indian languages;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) to (c) Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU) has informed that there is already a Centre of Indian Languages under the School of Language, Literature & Culture Studies in the University which offers programmes of M.A. and M.Phil./Ph.D. in Hindi and Urdu, and M.Phil./Ph.D. in Tamil. However, no decision has been taken to open a new school of Indian Languages.
