(a) Yes Madam.

(b) to (e) No civil aircraft is permitted to fly in the conflict zone. The destinations/zones which have been declared as no go zones are published in the Aeronautical Information Publication (AIP) of respective country. Notification for the information of all concerned regarding their respective airspace affected by the conflict is published by the respective country responsible for providing air traffic services. DGCA issues instructions from time to time to ensure safety of the Indian Registered

Aircrafts.
