#### ANSWER

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING [COL. RAJYAVARDHAN RATHORE (Retd.)]:

(a) to (b): The Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, in collaboration with National Film Development Corporation, Mumbai (NFDC) is organizing the first International Film Festival for Persons with disabilities (IFFPD) from 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> December, 2015 at Siri Fort Auditorium, New Delhi. The film festival has been conceptualized to honour the contributions of persons with disabilities on the occasion of International Day for Persons with Disabilities.

India and eighteen other countries are participating in the festival. A total number of 40 films (16 short films, 14 documentaries and 10 feature films) have been shortlisted for screening during the film festival, out of a large number of national and international entries received, by a panel of eminent curators. The films chosen for screening relate to different categories of disabilities.

There are also awards for Best Film and Best Director in each of the three categories of films with certificates and cash component.
