ART TREATMENT FOR HIV/AIDS PATIENTS

956. SHRI P.P. CHAUDHARY:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of HIV/AIDS patients in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether all HIV/AIDS patients have access to Anti-Retroviral drugs and treatment in the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor indicating the number of HIV/AIDS patients receiving Anti-Retroviral Treatment (ART), State/UT-wise;
- (d) whether denial of ART to some HIV/ AIDS patients have been reported from certain parts of the country, if so, the details thereof along with the action taken by the Government thereon; and
- (e) whether the Government proposes to implement the World Health Organisation's 'treat-all' recommendation that removes limitations on the eligibility for ART treatment HIV/AIDS patients, and if so, action plan drawn by the Government to implement the same?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

- (a): As of September 2015, a total of 11,57,787 people infected with HIV/AIDS are in active care at 519 Antiretroviral Therapy (ART) Centres across country, State/UT-wise details are at Annexure-I.
- (b): Yes, all PLHIV registered at Antiretroviral Therapy (ART) Centres and are found requiring ART are provided free Antiretroviral drugs and treatment.
- (c): As of September 2015, a total of 9,02,868 patients are receiving free ART treatment at 519 ART Centres across the country, State/UT wise details are at Annexure-II.
- (d): No, denial of Anti-Retroviral Treatment (ART) to patients are not reported from any parts of the country.
- (e): The Government has not yet proposed to implement the World Health Organisation's treatall recommendation.
