- (a) the details of schemes for modernization/upgradation/development of railway stations in the country;**
- (b) the funds allocated/utilised for the purpose especially in the backward/rural and tribal areas during the last three years and the current year, Zone and State/year-wise;**
- (c) the number of stations proposed and those developed as Adarsh Stations during the last three years, Zone-wise and State-wise;**
- (d) whether the Government has conducted any review of the facilities available at stations developed as Adarsh Stations and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (e) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to complete the upgradation of the remaining stations selected for the said purpose?**

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 5 BY DR. BHOLA SINGH AND SHRIMATI KAMLA DEVI PAATLE TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 24.02.2016 REGARDING ADARSH RAILWAY STATIONS.

(a): Yes, Madam. Upgradation of passenger amenities at stations in Indian Railways is undertaken under various schemes. At present, stations are undertaken for development under Adarsh Station Scheme.

(b): The expenditure on development of stations under 'Adarsh Station Scheme' is generally funded under Plan Head - 'Passenger Amenities'. State-wise details of funds allocated/spent are not maintained. The zone-wise allocation/expenditure under Plan Head 'Passenger Amenities', during the last three years and the current year is as under:-
