- (b) the present status of the said project along with the numbers of folk songs preserved through this mission, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the time by which the said project is likely to be implemented;
- (d) the amount sanctioned and spent so far on the said project; and
- (e) whether the Government proposes to sell it commercially and if so, the details thereof?

(a): Yes Madam, Prasar Bharati has informed that All India Radio has taken a special project “Public Estates Conservations Mega Project” to record ceremonial songs sung across various states on various occasions, to be preserved for posterity.

(b): Till date 7,407 ceremonial songs have been received in the AIR Directorate along with videography thereof, still photographs, musical notations, original scripts Hindi and English translations thereof. Out of 7,407, 1741 recording have been sent to AIR Archives for preservation after completion of formalities. State-wise details of recording under “Mega Project” are annexed.

(c): The project has already started in November 2014 and likely to be completed during the 13<sup>th</sup> five year plan

(d): Details of budget allocated and expenditure incurred are given as under:-
