(a): The overall internal security situation in the country is under control, as far as terrorism in the country is concerned. During current year, one incident of terror attack took place on 2nd January, 2016 at the Pathankot Air Force Station by terrorists infiltrated from Pakistan. In this incident, 7 Security Personnel and 1 civilian were killed. All the terrorists were neutralized by the Security Forces.

(b) & (c): Various State Governments have urged for effectively sealing the International Borders. Recently, the Chief Minister of Punjab has requested Ministry of Home Affairs to constitute a Committee for physical inspection of Border fencing in Punjab and adjoining areas of Jammu, identify the gaps and suggest measures to seal the gaps.
