- (a) whether a huge percentage of population in the country is not properly skilled and if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (b) whether the targets fixed by the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) to provide training could not be achieved;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor and the steps taken to achieve the future targets along with the target fixed for the next three years;
- (d) the total number of training centres set up by NSDC in the country, State-wise; and
- (e) whether it is proposed to set up more such centres in various parts of the country and if so, the details thereof?

STATEMENT TO BE LAID ON THE TABLE OF THE HOUSE IN RESPECT OF PART (a) TO (e) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 99 ADMITTED FOR REPLY ON 02.03.2016 REGARDING "ACHIEVEMENT OF PHYSICAL TARGETS"

(a) to (e) It is fact that majority of the workforce in the Country has undertaken informal skilling, up-skilling and re-skilling. Formal skill training has been taken by not more than 5 percent of the total workforce of the Country. To evolve appropriate skill development framework and removal of disconnect between the demand for and supply of skilled manpower through vocational and technical training, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship has been constituted by the Government on 9th November, 2014.

Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) has set up the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) as a Public Private Partnership entity to promote private training providers to set up skill development centres across the Country. The details of the funds allocated/spent by the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) for different activities related to skill development across the Country for the current financial year 2015-16 are as under:-

As on 31st January, 2016, NSDC training partners have 4,415 operational training centers, including 394 mobile centers across 28 States and 5 Union Territories which has the training programme in various sectors like Agriculture, Automobile, Building and Construction, Capital Goods, Gems and Jewellery, IT&ITES etc. State/UT-wise details of NSDC's operational training centres are given at **Annexure-I**.

Further, setting up of training centres is an ongoing process.

Besides, my Ministry has launched Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) on 15th July, 2015 which has the target to benefit 24 lakh persons across the Country with training of 14 lakh fresh entrants and certification of 10 lakh persons under Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) within one year. It is a skill certification and reward scheme wherein trainees after their successful assessment and certification, get monetary reward through direct bank transfer to their account. NSDC is the implementing agency for PMKVY.

As on 29th February, 2016, 14.69 lakh candidates have been enrolled for vocational training under different sectors across the Country with coverage of 29 States and 6 Union Territories (UTs). State/UT-wise break-up of enrolment made under PMKVY is given at **Annexure-II**.
