(a): Since railway projects generally straddle over more than one State, these are not sanctioned State-wise. As on 01.04.2015, there are 432 major ongoing projects on Indian Railways consisting of 155 New Lines, 42 Gauge Conversions and 235 Doublings. Zone-wise details of these projects are as under:-
