(a): The average revenue generated per day on various stations of the Western Railway for the year 2014-15 and 2015-16 (upto Jan.-2016) is as under:

(b)&(c): Yes, Madam. Stations have been categorized in seven categories i.e. A1, A, B, C, D, E and F based on the annual passenger earnings of the stations. Amenities are provided at the stations as per norms based on the category of the stations. Further, up-gradation of amenities is a continuous process and the same is undertaken based on the volume of passenger traffic handled at the station, inter-se priority of works etc. subject to availability of funds.
