Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the US Defence Department has conveyed the information to India regarding presence of nuclear weapons with Pakistan;
- (b) if so, the facts thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken/proposed to be taken to counter the situation?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) No. However, it is well known that Pakistan has developed and tested nuclear weapons. The Government monitors all developments which have a bearing on national security and is committed to taking all necessary steps to safeguard the nation's security.
