- (a) to (d) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Department of Telecommunication for collaboration in skill development in Telecom Sector. A National Action Plan for Skill Development in the Telecom Sector is a part of this MoU. Salient features and key objectives of the MoU are as under:p 8 88,
 - National Ecosystem for Development of Skills for the Telecom Sector
 - Utilize CSR funds of the PSUs under DoT for skilling purposes
 - National Institute for Policy Research Innovation and Training (NTIPRT)' for training of the trainers
 - Create 'Centres of Excellence' in different categories of training
 - bring in the internationally known best practices in the field of skill development and entrepreneurship for telecom sector,
 - Promote and scale up apprenticeship training in PSUs
 - Adoption of ITIs by the PSUs
 - Promote and facilitate Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)
 - alignment of courses with QP / NOS
